THE LAST TRUMP

Intro: Reading through Numbers, came across where God commands trumpets to be made. (Num. 10:1-9)

I. Two trumpets

- A. To be made of silver (beaten) hammered work. (Numbers 10:1)
- B. To be used for (vss.2-7) 1. Assembly of the congregation
 - 2. Movement of the people
- C. The sons of Aaron will blow the trumpets sounding an alarm. (vs. 8)
 - 1. When going to war (vs. 9)
 - 2. Be remembered and saved from enemies. (vs. 9)
- II. Feast of trumpets (Lev. 23:24, 25; Num. 29:1-6)
 - A. Held on first day of the seventh month.
 - B. A day of blowing the trumpets> memorial. (Lev. 23:24)
 - C. Celebrated after the captivity. (Neh. 7:73, 8:2, 9-12)

III. Used figuratively

A. Isa. 27:13- The great trumpet

B. Zech. 9:14- The Lord God will blow the trumpet.

IV. Symbolical

- A. Matt. 24:31- The great sound of the trumpet.
- B. 1st Cor. 15:52- The last trump
- C. 1st. Thess. 4:16- The Lord shall descend with a shout...and with the trumpet of God. (Rev. 1:7- every eye will see Him)

Conclusion: Are you ready for the Lord's coming?
